



MEMBER WELFARE POLICY

At Willoughby Swim Club (WSC), we hope to create an environment in which swimming is fun, enjoyable and safe for all of our members. We especially hold dear the safety of our children. For this reason, WSC's committee has agreed to adopt and abide by Swimming Australia's Safe Sport Framework. This Framework was originally developed by a committee of experienced people from a range of Swimming Australia member associations and in consultation with the Australian childhood Foundation and the Australian Sports Commission.

As stated on the Swimming Australia website, "The Framework is a critical piece of work to underpin the positive influence that swimming – and our swimming community – can have on the lives of all participants. It will also put swimming at the forefront of safeguarding children and member processes, procedures and resources in Australia."
